Call to Order.

Principal Report.

- Cell phone use has been a challenge. TMS has been trying different techniques to address behavior affecting the school community that stems from social media conversations and the teenage mental health crisis occurring from cell phone use. "Off and away" from 9:15am to 3:50pm has been the school's policy all year. Need help from parents so students can focus on school while at school. Will be working on education and engagement with parents.
- Upcoming events:
 - Second Outdoor School will be happening next week.
 - o Band concerts, choir concert, High School Musical
 - State testing is in May. Parents can opt-out of testing but it is very important for the school that students participate in testing. It can impact targeted funds and drives decisions for the school, the district, and the state.
 - School social is May 3 during the school day.
- TMS will be hosting summer school for three BSD middle schools. Summer school is for students that need support and intervention, not for enrichment. The goal is to have 100-130 TMS students enroll in summer school. The summer school day has been extended to 10am-3pm.
- Bargaining with the teachers' union started.
- TMS students are involved in numerous community events, including the state science fair, speech and debate, band competitions, and chess team.
